- February 2010** Publication of *The Mariner's Mirror*, Annual Bibliography, Newsletter and H. Murphy and D.J. Oddy, *Mirror of the Seas: A Centenary History of the Society for Nautical Research* (London, 2010)
- 13 May 2010** NASOH Annual Conference, Avery Point, Mystic Seaport. Centenary Lecture to be given by Professor Richard Harding at A.P. Bransford House, University of Connecticut. Reception at 16.00 hrs, lecture, 17.00 hrs.
- 16 June 2010** Reception and centenary lecture to be given in Whitehall, London SW1.
- 10 July 2010** Annual General Meeting and dinner on board HMS *Victory*.
- 15 September 2010** Reception and centenary lecture to be given at the Royal Society of Edinburgh.
- 29 September 2010** Professor Jeremy Black gives the first annual Alan Villiers memorial lecture at St Edmund's Hall.
- September 2010** Reception at the National Maritime Museum and address by Professor Roger Knight.
- 9 October 2010** 'The opening of Terra Australis'. A one-day conference sponsored by the SNR to be held at the National Museum of the Royal Navy, HM Dockyard, Portsmouth.
- February 2011** Publication of a special centenary issue of *The Mariner's Mirror*. This issue will contain 20 articles on topics chosen by the Hon. Editor to reflect the historical content of the journal.
- Spring 2011** An event will be held at *Trincomalee*, Jackson Dock, Hartlepool.
